# Suspicious behaviour in rural areas

In rural areas, the following can be targets for thieves: batteries, tool and small items of machinery; heating oil, metals; catalytic converters on vehicles and livestock.

If you see unfamiliar vehicles near your property or people acting suspiciously, don't wait for a crime to occur – contact the police on 101.

#### **Poachers**

Some poaching is carried out by organised crime gangs. Don't approach suspected poachers. Call 101 and provide location, time, date, description and registration numbers of vehicles.

#### **Project Servator**

We are continuing to do unpredictable deployments of Project Servator. Uniformed and plain clothed officers along with specially trained officers and other resource's, such as police dog units and Road Policing Group. We will be highly visible at the location, dates and times of the deployments are unpredictable, as will be the amount of officers available and other resources. The aim is to deter, detect and disrupt criminal activity and those with hostile intent.

In addition, they will strive to reassure communities and get them 'onside' and report all suspicious activity.
